I. Introduction to Disciplines and Main Research Fields

School of International And Public Affairs received a primary discipline master degree including Politics and Public Management. The Public Management coursework also includes a primary discipline doctoral degree, and is equipped with one post-doctoral program. The program is ranked 7th in the country for Public Management. The school has established the first research center of Shanghai Social Science and innovated Shanghai Soft Science research center, Shanghai City Social Survey Center, Public Policy and Governance Research Center, Innovation Center, National Strategic Studies Research Center, Japan Research Center, Israel Center, and other research institutions. It received "211 Project" support with three key discipline development projects, undertaking the national Ministry of Education and Shanghai Social Science planning of major projects as well as other key projects. We obtained National and Shanghai Excellent Course as well as National Excellent Resource Sharing Course and created a high per capita productivity in research than many other similar institutions. As talent training moves up to a higher step, the school has quickly won a reputation of excellence with other high level universities in China.

I. Faculty

1. Overview of Faculty

Of the existing 44 full-time teaching and research personnel at the School of International and Public Affairs, there are 15 professors, 20 associate professors, 15 doctoral supervisors all holding a PhD, including nearly half of which were obtained abroad. 2. Achievements

From 2009-2014, our faculty were involved in over 29 National Social Science foundation projects, including four projects supported by National Natural Science foundation, 24 projects supported by the Ministry of Education of Humanities and Social Science. We have published more than 420 SSCI, CISSI, and SCI papers in key academic journals in China and abroad, including more than eight national publishing monographs; published articles in major national newspapers and magazines, such as *Liberation Daily* and *Wenhui Daily*, articles numbering nearly 100 pieces. There are 12 of our faculty holding the post of International Academic Journal editors, including two top academic Journal editors. Our research papers has been published in a variety of Top SSCI journals in public management field such as, *Public Administration Review*, *International Public Management Journal*, and *the International Review of Public Administration*.

Our institution not only maintained a higher productivity in academic research, but also for the national and social development. The consultation report and policy advisory made by our professor were read by President Xi twice. Comments on the security situation surrounding China were instructed by President Xi,

The investigation of "The political consciousness of Chinese urban residents" obtained reference of President Xi. The report "The Chinese urban resident's environmental attitude worthy of attention" was awarded by the Ministry of Education as the annual outstanding expert proposal draft.

III. International cooperation

The School of International and Public Affairs regards internationalization and open-plan as an important school-running model, dedicating to build close academic exchanges with overseas universities. We have established cooperative partnerships with King College of England, Columbia University, the University of Michigan, Institut D'Etudes Politiques de Paris, University of Bergen Norway, Waseda University, and other world famous universities. We also have done much to explore internationalized talent cultivation and have invited foreign experts and professors to conduct academic research, make all-round substantive cooperation, and frequent international academic communication. At the same time, the institute has conducted serious exploration into international talent training, including the international undergraduate course system construction, improving the cultivation system of the postgraduates, and expanding the international student recruitment among other similar efforts.
