Then the students could choose to continue studying in JI or other majors provided by other engineering schools (in English or Chinese) of SJTU for bachelor's degree.

UM-SJTU Joint Institute (JI)

- > The UM-SJTU Joint Institute (JI) was jointly established by Shanghai Jiao Tong University and the University of Michigan. JI is to build a world-class teaching and research institute in China for nurturing innovative leaders with global visions. Students spend four years at JI and obtain a bachelor's degree in Mechanical Engineering (ME), Electrical and Computer Engineering (ECE), or Materials Science and Engineering (MSE) from SJTU.

How to Apply

Application Prerequisites

1. Healthy, non-Chinese citizens, foreign passport holders with senior high school diploma (or above)
2. Applicants of mainland China, Hong Kong, Macau and Taiwan who have immigrated to other countries should meet the conditions set by the "Document No. 83 (2009) of Ministry of Education of the PRC .pdf"

Application Deadlines

- > Early Action – November 15, 2017 (Beijing Time, GMT+8)
- > Regular Application – May 31st, 2018 (Beijing Time, GMT+8)

Application Materials

1. **Test Scores**
 - SAT (JI code: 6563)
 - ACT (JI code: 6983)
 - A-Level
 - IB (International Baccalaureate)
 - National Exam Scores, such as Malaysia National Exam Scores or others
 - TOEFL (iBT) (JI code: 6210) for non-native speakers of English
 - IELTS for non-native speakers of English
2. **Recommendations**
 - 2 recommendation letters are required: one from your high school counselor and one from a teacher
3. **High School Transcripts**
 - We pay special attention to math, physics, chemistry and other related subjects. Please arrange to have official copies of your transcripts in English sent to us by all high schools you attended.
4. **Self-statement**

English Proficiency Requirement

- > TOEFL (iBT) – 84 or above
- > IELTS – 6 or above
- > Exceptions
 - If SAT critical reading score is 600 or above, or both your ACT reading and English scores are 27 or higher.
 - Recently completed at least 4 years of rigorous academic study in any of the following countries: Anguila, Antigua, Barbuda, Australia, Bahamas, Barbados, Bermuda, British Virgin Islands, Canada (except Quebec), Cayman Islands, Dominica, England, Federated States of Micronesia, Grenada, Guyana, Ireland, Jamaica, Montserrat, New Zealand, Northern Ireland, Scotland, Seychelles, Shetland Islands, St. Kitts-Nevis, St. Lucia, St. Vincent and the Grenadines, Trinidad and Tobago, Turks and Caicos Islands, United States (other than Puerto Rico), US Virgin Islands, Wales.

Financial Aid & Scholarships

- > Excellent Students will be awarded scholarships, such as Chinese Government Scholarship, Shanghai Government Scholarship, Teaching Assistantships, or others.
- > Students applying for Chinese Government Scholarship should directly to the local Chinese embassy or consulate. When completing the scholarship application form, the applicant should select Shanghai Jiao Tong University as the first priority.

Tuition

- > CNY 80,000 (Approx. US\$ 12,000)

Application Fee

- > All applicants are required to pay a nonrefundable application fee of USD\$ 75.

Term begins

- > In early September 2018 (the specific date will be informed on the admission letter)

Accommodation

- > The university would like to provide a wider range of housing selection to the international student so that you could choose the dormitory freely in different prices and types and you could also look for an off-campus residence.
- > International students applying for on-campus accommodation are required to book dormitory online. The information in details will be informed with admission letter.

Health Insurance

- > The relevant regulations by the Ministry of Education of People's Republic of China and the Management Regulations for International Student of SJTU require that all international students with study duration over 6 months should purchase the Group Comprehensive Insurance in Mainland China. The student without valid Group Comprehensive Insurance or the student who doesn't submit the valid insurance document to the ISSC will NOT be allowed to register in a new semester.
- > The premium of the Group Comprehensive Insurance: RMB800/one year, RMB400/half year. Please log in www.lxbx.net to look up and download the detailed information on the Group Comprehensive Insurance such like the articles, insurance liabilities, insurance claims etc.

Visa affairs

- > Student visas are only available for international students who have been enrolled by SJTU.
- > The international students may apply for X1 and X2 visa to the local Chinese Embassy or Consulate, and enter into China within one week before the day of registration. An international student with an X1 visa shall apply for a residence permit within 30 days after entry into China. Those who fail to make the application and continue to stay with expired visas are treated as illegal stay and will be imposed the penalty prescribed by the law.
- > The detailed information on visa application and residence permit will be informed with admission letter.
