1. Summer Chinese Programs

[Application Requirements]

- 1. A passport with a valid Residence permit.
- 2. Aged from 18 to 55 and in good health.
- 3. Abide by the laws of the People's Republic of China and observe the rules and regulations of the university

Semesters & Registration periods

The program span from July to August, with 4-weeks program and 6—weeks program respectively. Registration time: March 1st to May 31st

【Fees 】 nonrefundable

1. Application Fee: RMB 450 (about \$85)

2. Tuition: Four weeks RMB 3,850/term (about \$650)

Six weeks RMB 5,550/term (about \$930)

3. Tuition for Optional Course: Four weeks RMB 300/course (about \$50)

Six weeks RMB400/Course (about \$700)

materials and textbook fee excluded

4. Fees for Extracurricular activities: The fee may vary with the market price

Note: The students who apply for both the summer Chinese Program and the Autumn full time program at the same time, student only need fill the application form for Fall-term (choose "Chinese Language Program", "Full-time (long-term) Program"), an email is required to iso@sjtu.edu.cn to confirm the application fee (RMB¥450) once only. Applicants are required to pay the full amount tuition for both the summer and fall term on the registration day of the summer program. If the two courses are applied separately, two application forms and double application fees will be requested.

Course Description (A minimum number of 12 students is required to start a class)

Main courses: The courses are designed for 20 students per class on average with a placement test on the registration day

- Intensive Chinese: seven levels: A to G
- Business Chinese: two levels: intermediate and advanced
- Chinese Heritage Learners (Huayiban): for students with Chinese background who can communicate in Chinese (Mandarin or Chinese dialects) in daily life but have very limited ability in reading and writing Chinese characters (knowing less than 200 Chinese characters).

School time (20 class hour a week, one class hour is 45 minutes)

Monday to Friday: 8:20 to 9:50 and 10:10 to 11:40

Optional courses & Extracurricular activities

Optional courses: (A minimum number of 10 students is required to start a class)

> Once a week (Tue. or Thu.) (90 minutes each time)

Chinese calligraphy, Chinese Paper cutting (control in 25 students per class)

Martial Arts, Tai Chi (control in 15 students per class)

> Twice a week (Mon. & Wed.) (90 minutes each time)

Chinese Character, Test-taking Skill for HSK (from level 4) (control in 30 students per class)

Extracurricular activities: Huangpu River Night Cruise, Acrobatics Show, One-day trip to Suzhou, Two-day trip to Hangzhou &Wuzhen (A group will be composed of 15 students at minimum.)

[Payment Method]

- 1. Application Fee: to be paid by online, remittance. A scanned copy of the transfer receipt is requested to caicheng@sjtu.edu.cn & iso@sjtu.edu.cn after the remittance
- 2. Tuition: to be paid by remittance before registration day or by bank card or credit card on the registration day. The acceptable bank cards include China UnionPay, VISA and MASTER. The extra charge (1.9%) of international bank cards is to be paid by students themselves.

2. Short-term Chinese Programs for groups

SJTU also provides groups study programs for the organizations who wish to put the group into a same class. A minimum of 15 students at the same level in a class. The curriculum and schedule can be

tailored for students from the groups. There are rich, diversified courses to be selected. Programs fee are up to negotiation between two parties, with the student number, length of schooling, course number etc. taken into account.

Application Procedure

Step 1: Online application, Register with your email address, sign in with your email address and initial password, complete online application on the web-site of http://apply.sjtu.edu.cn

Step 2: Upload Documents:

- 1. A photocopy of your passport page with personal information and photo. (jpg, ≤3MB)
- 2. A photocopy of your recent photo (jpg, 2.2x2.8cm, 300 pixels/inch, ≤10k, Bareheaded).
- 3. If you are studying at another university/school in China, please submit a study transcript and an attendance letter issued by the International Student Office or the school of your host university with their contact information.

Step 3: Pay the application fee 450 yuan: It could be online payment paid, wire transfer through the bank or paying in credit/banking card in our office. Please DON'T transfer through ATM.

Step 4: Submit the application form

[Admission and registration]

- 1. We will issue an Admission Notice and Visa Application for Study in China (JW202 form) to those who are accepted by Shanghai Jiao Tong University.
- 2. The admitted students should bring their ordinary passport, Admission Notice and Visa Application for Study in China (JW202 form) and other required documents to the Embassy or Consulate of the People's Republic of China to apply for a student Visa (X1 or X2).
- 3. The student shall come to Shanghai Jiao Tong University for registration on the registration date indicated on the Admission Notice.
- 4. Students will be required to check passport and visa, buy insurance, pay the tuition, placement test and so on during the registration day.

[Insurance]

According to the pertinent regulations of the Ministry of Education and the school, the school will exercise full-member insurance system for the international students. International students must cover the insurance in accordance with relevant national regulations and school requirements. Students who fail to purchase the insurance in accordance with the regulations shall cover the insurance within stipulated time, or they will not be recruited by the school; if the students have already studied in the school, then they shall be requested to quit school or rejected for registration.
