# **Research Collaboration**

SIPA faculty are active researchers, with works appearing in top-ranked international and national academic presses and Chinese-and-English-language scholarly journals such as Chinese Social Science, Public Administration Review, Asian Survey, and International Organization. Over the past five years, SIPA faculty have published more than 60 authored, co-authored, and edited books, around 500 articles in SSCI, CSSCI, EI, and A&HCI indexed journals, not to mention innumerable research reports and conference papers.

Reflecting its commitment to research, SIPA houses a number of research centers. These centers include Shanghai Social Science Innovation Center, Public Opinion and Survey Research Center, Non-Profit Sector Research Center, Taiwan Studies Center, Japan Center, Israeli Studies Center, Center for the Study of Multinational Corporations, and Urban Studies Center.



# **International Cooperation**

SIPA's high degree of internationalization is one of its outstanding features. This is reflected in its leadership and faculty composition, its steady stream of distinguished visitors, and its international symposium on topics such as China-Japan-US relations, public service, local governance, and performance. SIPA has formal agreements with more than 20 universities and research institutes in Australia, France, Hong Kong, Japan, Russia, Singapore, and the United States. These agreements cover the gamut including faculty exchange, student exchange, joint research projects, double and joint degree programs, and collaborative short-term study programs.
